

# ***BECAS CON BENDICIONES***

## ***(SCHOLARSHIPS WITH BLESSINGS)***

**An opportunity to provide scholarships for children in Honduras.**

*Public schools in Honduras are "free", but many children are unable to attend because of entry fees, uniforms and school supplies they are required to purchase. This program provides support for children who are selected by local committees for the school year which begins in February and ends in November. Becas con Bendiciones mission is to help the poorest of the poor get an education.*

*Applications for scholarships are received through the local Methodist mission churches and then prioritized by the local pastors and a committee of laity. The number of children who will have the opportunity to attend school is based on the funds received into this program by January of each year. This is a ministry that will impact these children for their entire lives and involves the whole child. The spiritual component is highlighted by a "Gathering" each month led by the pastors and coordinators of the program involving the children in Bible study, singing and prayer.*

*YOU are invited to join others in this partnership with God to change lives of Honduran children. Through prayer, encouragement, and your financial contribution, Honduran children can have an education, which will help break the cycle of poverty in their country and allow these children to grow in self worth and come to know Jesus Christ as their Savior. Existing donors will be assigned the same child or children in succeeding years.*

*Children will receive the following encouragement from you and others:*

- prayers of pastors, local church and sponsors*
- each child receiving a scholarship will also receive a Bible*
- daily prayer with parents is encouraged*
- celebration at the end of the school year*
- monthly "Gathering" to encourage them in their faith*

*Scholarships provide:*

- matriculation and graduation fees*
- uniforms and leather shoes*
- school supplies and back pack*
- gym clothes and tennis shoes*
- Bible*
- daily chewable multiple vitamins*
